

CLUB RULES

NAME AND OBJECT

- 1. The name of the Club is the "Penzance Sailing Club" and the Burgee of the Club shall be a black skull and crossbones on a white background.
- 2. The objects of the Club are the encouragement of boat sailing, cruising and racing and the maintenance of a Clubhouse for the use of Members of the Club.

MEMBERSHIP

- 3. All members of either sex, whether owners of a boat or yacht or not, who are interested in sailing are eligible for Membership.
- 4. For the purpose of these Rules the following definitions shall apply:
- (a) A FULL member is any Member over eighteen years of age who has paid the Full Membership subscription.
- (b) A STUDENT member is any member over eighteen years of age and under twenty one who elects to pay the reduced Student Subscription: he may continue as a STUDENT Member beyond the age of twenty one whilst he continues to receive full time education.
- (c) A CADET Member is any Member under the age of eighteen but not less than eleven. Cadet membership may be granted to a member under the age of eleven years, provided that at all times they are under the supervision of a parent, or other adult member.
- (d) An OUT OF PORT Member is one who lives more than 25 miles from the Club.
