## NOTES AND NEWS

For the 1957 Season points races will be held on Monday (instead of Tuesday) and Thursday evenings and on Saturday afternoons. Evening races will be started at 6.45 p.m. until the end of July and thereafter at 6.30 p.m. while afternoon races will be started at 3 p.m.

On seven Saturdays during the season and at Penzance Regatta the Jollities and Ospreys and 18ft. Jolly Boats will be racing at Penzance while on seven other Saturdays and at Marazion Regatta the Redwings will be racing at the Mount. The Jollities and Ospreys will race together at Penzance for a cup presented by Mr J. R. Bazeley and called the "Penzance Cup."

\* \* \*

The Club have been fortunate to retain their Club-house for at least one more season and during the Summer this will be open on Monday and Thursday evenings, Saturday afternoons and Sunday mornings. Notice of any alterations to these arrangements will be posted on the Club Notice Board.

\* \* \*

Councillor S. Peak, the Mayor Elect of Penzance, has kindly presented a Challenge Cup to be called the "Mayor of Penzance Trophy" for competition by local Redwings. This will be awarded to the boat gaining most points in the six races marked "T" in the programme.

\* \* \*

During last year's National Redwing Dinghy Championships Neville Noye sailed consistently well in his new boat Nimbus (No. 179) being 2nd in the Championship Race and 2nd and 3rd in two other races.

The Penzance Challenge Trophy was won easily by the Club Team two boats being placed 1st and 2nd.

Redwing No. 77 (Vega) will again be available this season for use as a Club Boat on Monday and Thursday evenings to encourage younger members. Anyone wishing to sail her should contact Mr N. Noye; a charge of 5/- per race will be made.

In a further endeavour to encourage new Sailing members it is planned to hold a series of instructional races on certain Sunday mornings during the season and the Vice-Commodore (A. Franklyn Pool) has offered to present a trophy for competition by members under 20 years of age. Particulars of these races will be posted on the Club Notice Board in due course.

\* \* \*

The new rule requiring life-jackets to be used by all helmsmen and crews while racing in certain conditions will be strictly enforced. The Rule is:—

1. Life-jackets for each member of the crew shall be carried in boats when racing at ALL times.
2. Cadet Members of the Club must wear life-jackets at ALL times when they are sailing.
3. Life-jackets must be WORN by ALL members and crews sailing in Club Races when it is so decided by the senior flag officer or committee member present at the start.
4. Failure to carry out these rules will result in the disqualification of the boat.

## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR P.S.C. RACES.

### 1. COURSE FLAGS.

- International Code flag "A," "X," "Y," or "R."
- Red or Green flag indicating port or starboard.
- 2, 3 or 4 Black and White pennants indicating 2, 3 or 4 rounds.

### 2. CLASS FLAGS.

- National Redwings "V" (Red Cross on White Ground).
- Jollities and Ospreys "J" (Blue, White, Blue Horizontal Stripes).
- 18ft. Jolly Boats "C" (Blue, White, Red, White, Blue Horizontal Stripes).

3. **STARTING LINE.** An imaginary line through two Black and White posts surmounted by triangles near the end of Penzance Pierhead. The distance mark, which also serves as a mark for certain courses, will be a Red and Yellow buff; and there will be an inner limit mark about 30 yards from the pierhead.

All races start North to South and finish South to North, over this line, between the two buffs.

- RECALL.** Will be by gun and megaphone. Sail numbers will be used as recall numbers.
- LATE STARTERS.** May paddle clear of North Arm after the five minute gun provided they stop so as to ensure that they carry no way therefrom over the line.
- STARTING PROCEDURE.**

10 MINUTES before the start, course flags will be hoisted and a gun fired or other sound signal given.

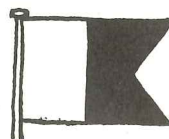

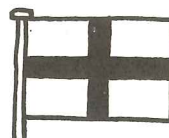

**"A" COURSE PORT.** After start leave Gear Mark to Starboard for first time, thereafter Newlyn Mark, Low Lee Buoy and Gear Mark all to Port. Return to finishing line after appropriate number of rounds.

**"A" COURSE STARBOARD.** After start leave Gear Mark, Low Lee Buoy and Newlyn Mark all to Starboard. At end of last round leave Gear Mark to Port and return to finishing line.

**DISTANCE.**  $2\frac{3}{4}$  miles per lap, total for three laps, plus starting and finishing legs,  $9\frac{1}{4}$  miles.

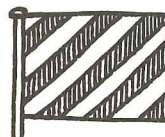

**"X" COURSE PORT.** Leave Gear Mark, Wreck Buoy, and Start Buoy all to Port (except Start Buoy at finish).

**"X" COURSE STARBOARD.** After Start leave Wreck Buoy, Gear Mark and Start Buoy all to Starboard.

**DISTANCE.**  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles per lap, total for three laps  $4\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

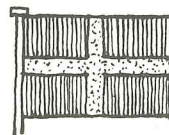
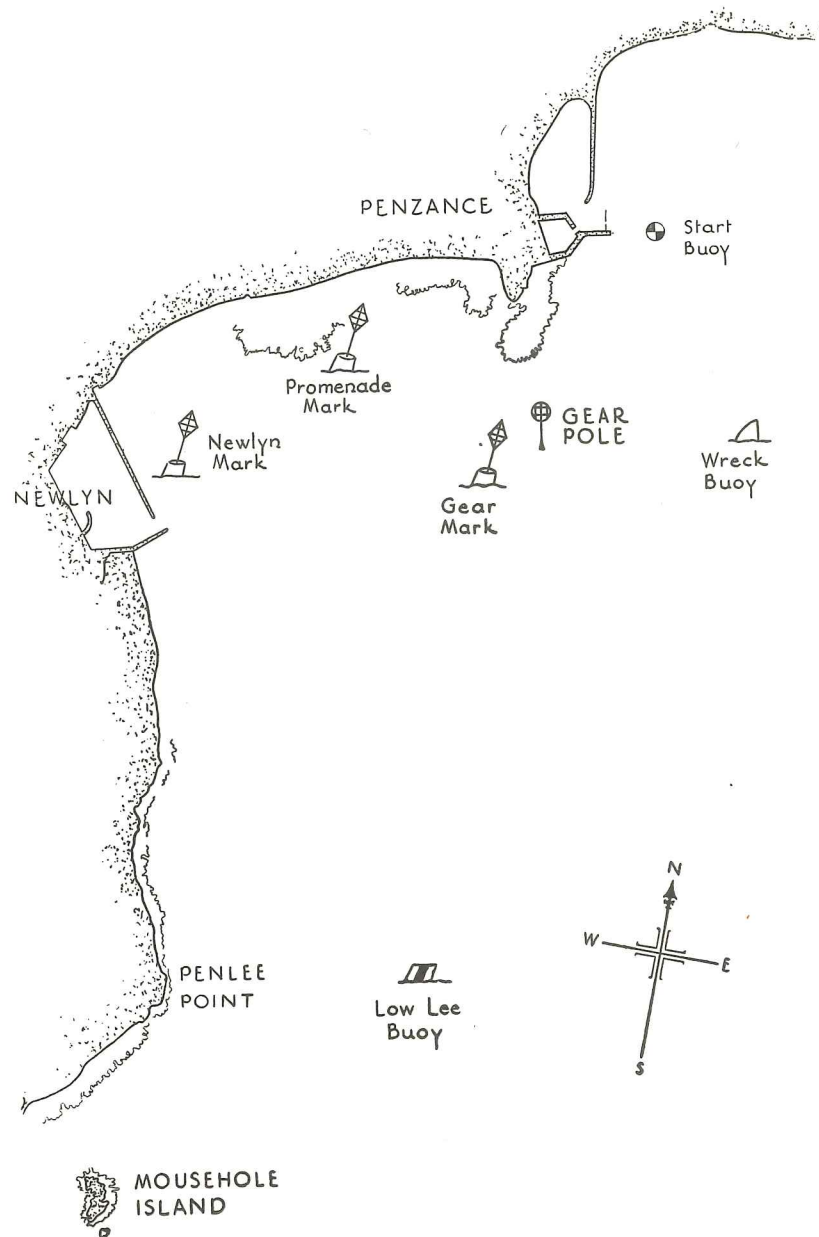

**"Y" COURSE PORT.** After Start leave Gear Mark to Starboard first time, thereafter Promenade Mark, Newlyn Mark and Gear Mark all to Port. Return to finishing line after appropriate number of rounds.

**"Y" COURSE STARBOARD.** After Start leave Gear Mark, Newlyn Mark and Promenade Mark all to Starboard. At end of last round leave Gear Mark to Port and return to finishing line.

**DISTANCE.**  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles per lap, total for three laps, plus starting and finishing legs,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

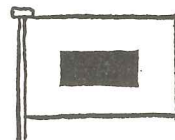

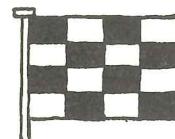
"R" COURSE STARBOARD. After Start leave Wreck Buoy, Low Lee Buoy and Newlyn Mark all to Starboard. At end of last round leave Wreck Buoy to Port and return to finishing line.



#### 8. SHORTENING COURSE.

Code flag "S" will be hoisted and a gun fired or other sound signal given to indicate that the race is to finish with the round about to be completed.

"S" Blue on White.



#### 9. CANCELLATION OF RACE.

Code flag "N" will be hoisted to indicate cancellation.

"N" Blue and White.

10. All races will be sailed under R.Y.A. Rules except Rules 5 (Entries) and 11 (Declarations). A Rectangular Racing flag not less than 4 ins. by 6 ins. must be clearly displayed at the masthead while racing; if any boat fouls a mark or another boat she must at once haul down her flag and retire, or if another boat is to blame, hoist a protest flag.

11. PROTESTS. Must be lodged with the Secretary in writing within 24 hours of the start of the race, in accordance with R.Y.A. Rule 38.

Protests will be heard on the next succeeding evening Club Race fixture night or as soon thereafter as practicable.

R.Y.A. Rule 40 shall not apply to Club Races.
